- **The Person:** To qualify for this position you require completion of an approved Diagnostic Medical Sonographer Program, hold active registration with CSDMS and certification with CARDUP (including: Core and Generalist) and/or ARDMS (including: Sonography Principles and Instrumentation, Obs/Gyne and Abdomen), Demonstrated high quality clinical scanning skills, excellent written and verbal communication skills in conjunction with exceptional patient care skills, ability to work independently as well as part of a dynamic multi-disciplinary team, demonstrated effective decision making, problem solving and organizational skills, history of good work and attendance record required. Current experience as a Diagnostic Medical Sonographer in a hospital setting is an asset but new graduates are encouraged to apply.
