THE POSITION

Under the supervision of the Program Manager of the Children's Services Team, this position is responsible for community outreach and case management to Aboriginal children and their families aged 0 through 12 years of age. The children and their families have multiple and complex issues which might include mental health needs and developmental and behavioural issues. The incumbent provides support to the families of these children, direction in regard to behavioural management and the development and coordination of service plans. Collaboration with many other professionals and agencies is required. The incumbent will be expected to work in partnership with education and will provide services within the context of the school as well as the home and community based locations.

THE PERSON

- Baccalaureate Degree in Social Work or Indian Social Work.
- Registration with the Saskatchewan Association of Social Workers.
- Knowledge, skills and experience in behavioural management with children.
- Direct knowledge of and experience with Aboriginal culture and customs.
- The ability to speak one or more Aboriginal languages would be considered an asset.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Exceptional interpersonal skills and recent experience working in a multidisciplinary mental health setting for children.
- Case management training and recent experience working with families of children aged 0 to 12 years with Mental health problems.
- Successful experience working collaboratively with community agencies and professionals.
- Strong organizational and leadership skills.
- Good attendance required.
