## **The Opportunity**

The Department is a unified department that combines the academic, research, and service components within Saskatoon Health Region and the University of Saskatchewan College of Medicine. The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine has an accredited residency training program in General Pathology and is involved in the training of undergraduates, graduate students, and post-doctoral fellows. The Department's broad range of clinical programs includes subspecialty aspects of pathology that are well suited for educational and research activities. The Department includes the Division of Anatomical Pathology (including Histology and Cytopathology), Medical Biochemistry, Hematopathology, Microbiology, Virology, Tissue Typing, Cytogenetics, Inherited Metabolic Diseases, Diagnostic Molecular Pathology, and Transfusion Medicine. The Division of Anatomical Pathology serves a population base of approximately 500,000 and has a staff of 16 staff pathologists, including specialists in neuro- and renal pathology. The role includes protected time for administrative duties, involves responsibility for multiple sites, and offers the opportunity to influence and support Anatomical Pathology services at a provincial level. The competitive compensation package includes a stipend, as well as generous vacation and benefits.

## **The Candidate**

The successful candidate will have a passion for clinical leadership focusing on the combined service/academic mission of Saskatoon Health Region and the University of Saskatchewan, as well as a strong interest in system planning and quality improvement, and will have or be eligible for licensure in Saskatchewan. ### **Reporting Relationship**

The Division Head, Anatomical Pathology reports to the Joint Head, Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine; and the Director, SHR Pathology and Laboratory Medicine.

### **The Region**

Saskatoon Health Region is an integrated health delivery agency in Saskatchewan serving more than 300,000 residents in more than 110 cities, towns, and rural municipalities. Saskatoon Health Region is the largest employer in the province, with 13,000 staff and 900 physicians across the Region providing a complete range of health services to residents of central and northern Saskatchewan. The Region's urban acute care hospitals – St. Paul's, Saskatoon City, and Royal University – comprise three of the Province's tertiary teaching facilities.

### **The University**

A publicly funded institution established in 1907, the University of Saskatchewan offers a full range of curricula, both academic and professional, with students registered in 13 colleges, including health sciences (medicine, nursing, dentistry, physiotherapy, kinesiology, pharmacy and nutrition) and veterinary sciences. The University of Saskatchewan is home to key resources, including the Canadian Light Source, Canada's national synchrotron research facility.

### **Canadian Light Source (CLS) Synchrotron**

The \$173.5 million CLS synchrotron, a national facility owned by the University of Saskatchewan, is the largest science project in Canada in more than 30 years. This facility focuses on science and innovation for academic, industrial, and governmental researchers. An active Anatomy and Cell Biology CLS Users Group is available for collaborative research with clinical faculty.

### **The City**

With a population of 230,000, Saskatoon is the largest city in Saskatchewan, offering numerous events, festivals, and attractions. The city has a strong arts and music focus, a variety of indoor and outdoor sporting facilities, and more golf courses per capita than any city in North America. Saskatoon is a short drive from northern lake country and the international airport makes travel to and from the city convenient. Saskatoon has walking and biking trails along the river bank and its educational facilities include the University of Saskatchewan.
