

Family Practice Opportunity – Humboldt, Saskatchewan



The Area

Humboldt, home of the Humboldt Broncos hockey team is a vibrant community of 5,940. The community is located 100 kilometres east of Saskatoon and boasts a full range of health care, cultural, and sporting centres including an indoor aquatic center.

Saskatoon Health Region (SHR)

SHR is one of the most integrated and complex health delivery agencies in Canada and is the largest health region in Saskatchewan, serving more than 300,000 residents in over 100 cities, towns, and rural municipalities. Saskatoon Health Region is the largest single employer in the province with over 12,000 staff and 800 physicians.

The Opportunity

We seek two permanent full time physicians. The physicians will provide services to the residents of Humboldt and surrounding area. Compensation is on a fee-for-service basis. In collaboration with the SHR, relocation and loan assistance is available. The SHR also offers a Grant to newly graduating University of Saskatchewan Family Medicine Residents.

The Humboldt District Hospital has 36 beds and is currently served by 8 doctors. The facility provides general medicine, obstetrics, surgery and emergency services. Other services provided at the hospital include laboratory, radiology, physiotherapy, palliative care, dietary counseling, chemotherapy and ultra sound.

Cardiology, urology, gynecology, internal medicine, ENT, podiatry and orthopaedic services are provided by specialists on a visiting itinerant basis. Construction of the new Humboldt district hospital, pictured above right, will be complete late winter 2011.

A Saskatchewan Medical License, Canadian Medical Protective Association coverage, Canadian residency/immigration status, and eligibility for membership on the Saskatoon Health Region Practitioner Staff are required. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, in accordance with immigration requirements, Canadian and permanent residents will be given preference.
