The Area

Come and explore the friendly community of Lanigan. Lanigan is located in south-central Saskatchewan on the Yellowhead Highway, only 117 km to the east of Saskatoon and 170 km to the north of Regina. The community of 1,233 serves a catchment area of approximately 5,000 people, prides itself as the home to one of the largest potash mines in North America and is the home of the largest feedlot and ethanol plant in Canada. A short distance from Lanigan is the renowned Manitou Springs Resort and Mineral Spa, which offers a European-style mineral spa, therapeutic and esthetic services, fitness centre and resort hotel. For the camping enthusiast, the Manitou & District Regional Park offers full-service camp sites, swimming, nature trails and a picturesque golf course with grass greens and driving range.

Lanigan boasts a K-12 school, licensed government subsidized daycare centre, various seasonal and year-round recreational activities, a full range of health care services, including an acute care hospital, 35-bed Long Term Care facility, ambulance, therapies, mental health, home care, addictions and public health services. The Region

Saskatoon Health Region is one of the most integrated and complex health delivery agencies in Canada.
