

Department of Academic Family Medicine Family Physician (Locum) West Winds Primary Health Centre, Saskatoon SK

A rewarding opportunity exists for a family physician (with CFPC) in the **Saskatoon Unit** of the Department of Academic Family Medicine. This contract locum opportunity (to cover a sabbatical leave) of up to 6 months duration and up to 9 half days per week may commence on/after November 1, 2011; is located at the West Winds Primary Health Centre and involves a balance of patient care; and teaching/supervision of family medicine residents and undergraduate medical students.

We are particularly interested in hearing from physicians who are interested in sharing their knowledge, expertise and experience in Family Medicine through teaching and providing patient care in a clinical environment.

Our Department has 28 full-time faculty members, 77 residents and consists of six divisions; including Saskatoon Urban, Regina Urban, Rural (Prince Albert and Swift Current), Emergency Medicine (Saskatoon & Regina), Research and Northern Medical Services. Physicians and residents in all locations participate in the provision of a broad range of patient care, including adult medicine, obstetrics, pediatrics and in-hospital/nursing home care.

The Saskatoon Unit is located in the West Winds Primary Health Centre. Physicians enjoy the benefits of a dynamic interdisciplinary team environment to support their clinical work and their teaching.

The College of Medicine is one of 6 health sciences colleges at the University of Saskatchewan with approximately 270 university based faculty and over 800 community faculty; these clinical faculty are distributed throughout all 13 Saskatchewan health regions. The College of Medicine has an enrolment of approximately 250 undergraduate and 300 postgraduate medical students.
