### The Area

The pretty town of Rosthern is located in the heart of the valley between the North and South Saskatchewan Rivers, and midway between Saskatoon and Prince Albert – a travel distance of 35 minutes to each city.

The sporting facilities are second to none in Rosthern. The new Valley Aquatic Centre features a junior-size Olympic outdoor pool with a zero-depth entrance and a new change room facility. The Jubilee Sports Centre houses an arena and a curling rink, both with artificial ice. Other sporting venues used by many include the shale ball diamonds and batting cages, soccer fields, tennis courts, bowling alley and football field. The four designated walking trails promote health, fitness and other activities such as bird-watching

The arts play an important role in Rosthern with the Station Arts Centre located in downtown Rosthern, and the old CN station converted into an art gallery, with seminar space, a tea room and performing arts theatre.

The town and the province are proud of the popular Valley Regional Park which boasts a championship 18-hole golf course, campground with 65 campsites, the large creative playground and games area, ball diamond, mini golf and concession are also available.

Rosthern's business section has over 100 retail, service and home-based businesses within the community. Health facilities include a hospital, physician clinic with 6 physicians, a chiropractic clinic and community services clinic. There are plenty of seniors accommodations and services. Emergency services such as ambulance, fire department, rescue squad and RCMP are all located in town.

Educational facilities include an elementary school, a high school, a junior college (private school) and an adult education centre.

### Saskatoon Health Region (SHR)

SHR is one of the most integrated and complex health delivery agencies in Canada and is the largest health region in Saskatchewan, serving more than 300,000 residents in over 100 cities, towns and rural municipalities. Saskatoon Health Region is the largest single employer in the province with over 12,000 staff and 800 physicians.

### The Opportunity

The Physicians in Rosthern are an experienced group of Physicians who provide service to residents of Rosthern and surrounding area and enjoy a wide scope of practice including clinic, inpatient, emergency and long term care medicine. The call rotation is 1:6 with the Physician retaining 100% of the on-call stipend. Overhead fees are very reasonable. Compensation is on a fee-for-service basis. In collaboration with the SHR, relocation and loan assistance is available for permanent

candidates. The SHR also offers a grant to newly graduating University of Saskatchewan Family Medicine Residents.

A Saskatchewan Medical License, Canadian Medical Protective Association coverage, Canadian residency/immigration status and eligibility for membership on the Saskatoon Health Region Practitioner Staff are required. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, in accordance with immigration requirements, Canadian and permanent residents will be given preference.
