The area boasts K-12 schools, various seasonal and year-round recreational activities, a full range of health care services (12-bed hospital, Health Centre, 46-bed Long Term Care facility in Wakaw, 29-bed Long Term Care facility with 4 multi-purpose beds in Cudworth, ambulance, therapies, mental health, home care, addictions and public health services). 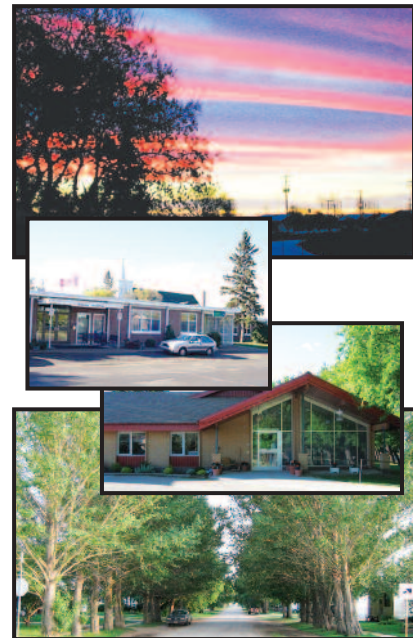
The Opportunity
