The Area

The Town of Watrous, a progressive community of 1800, is ideally located near the centre of the populated area of the province, right in the center of the Canadian grain-belt.

Located 110 km southeast of Saskatoon and 175 km northwest of Regina, Watrous is well-known for the healing waters of Lake Manitou, the beach, The Mineral Spa, CBK Radio, Danceland, Camp Easter Seal, and it's thriving economic center based upon agriculture, tourism, mining, and industry.

The Town came into being in 1906, when the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway established a divisional point at the town site. The people soon realized the medicinal properties of Manitou Lake, and today, thousands of people visit Watrous and Manitou Beach to test the mysterious waters of Little Manitou Lake. municipalities. Saskatoon Health Region is the largest single employer in the province with over 12,000 staff and 800 physicians.

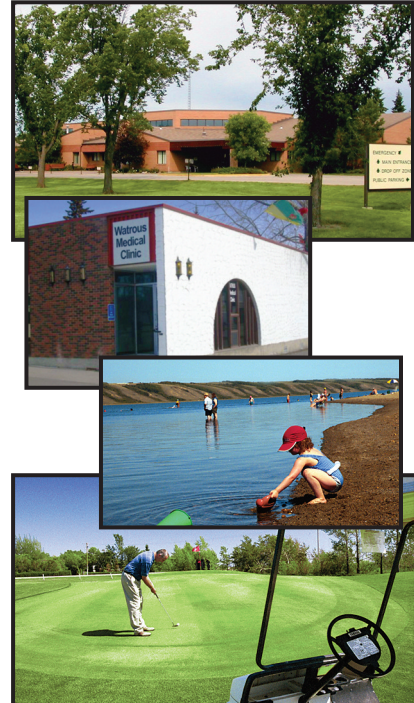
The Opportunity

A capital project, with construction to begin in fall 2010, is underway to replace the existing LTC facility. An addition to the existing Watrous Hospital will result in a fully integrated health facility in the community. This facility will house 8 acute care beds, 43 LTC beds, Home Care, Mental Health, Public Health, therapies, ambulance and a variety of visiting health services.

The physician provides services to the residents of Watrous and surrounding area. Compensation is on a fee-for-service basis. In collaboration with the SHR, relocation and loan assistance is available. The SHR also offers a Grant to newly graduating University of Saskatchewan Family Medicine Residents.

A Saskatchewan Medical License, Canadian Medical Protective Association coverage, Canadian residency/immigration status, and eligibility for membership on the Saskatoon Health Region Practitioner Staff are required.

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, in accordance with immigration requirements, Canadian and permanent residents will be given preference.
