SHR is one of the most integrated and complex health delivery agencies in Canada and is the largest health region in Saskatchewan, serving more than 300,000 residents in over 100 cities, towns, and rural municipalities. Saskatoon Health Region is the largest single employer in the

province with over 12,000 staff and 800 physicians.

The Opportunity

Wynyard Community Clinic has two full-time, salaried, General Practice opportunities available. The well established, completely furnished and well equipped Clinic is located just a few blocks away from the Wynyard Integrated Hospital, long term care and community services facility. Currently 4 GP's and 1 Nurse Practitioner provide care to the 2000 residents of Wynyard and surrounding area.

Exciting features include a competitive salary (not fee for service), paid CMPA/licensing fees/dues, 2 weeks paid CME time, CME allowance, and in collaboration with the SHR, relocation and loan assistance. The SHR also offers a Grant to newly graduating University of Saskatchewan Family Medicine Residents.

A Saskatchewan Medical License, Canadian Medical Protective Association coverage, Canadian residency/immigration status, and eligibility for membership on the Saskatoon Health Region Practitioner Staff are required.

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, in accordance with immigration requirements, Canadian and permanent residents will be given preference.
