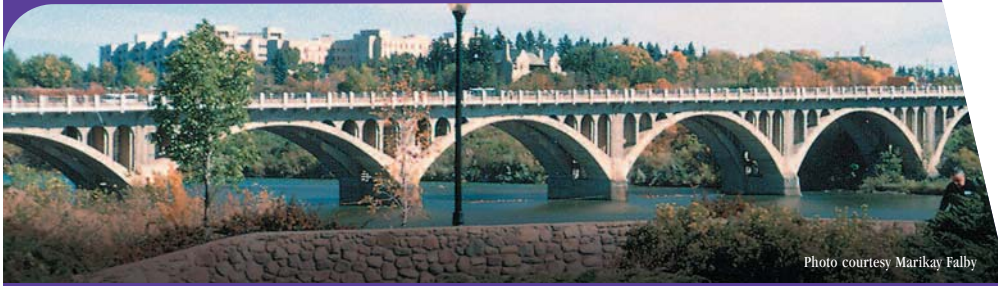

Exciting General Practitioner and General Practitioner Anesthetist opportunities exist in several rural communities within the Saskatoon Health Region.

## The Province

Located in the heart of North America, Saskatchewan has a population of 996,000, observes Central Standard Time year round, and has agriculture, mining, manufacturing, and tourism as principal industries. The highest elevation is 1,392 m above sea level. Our four major river systems all empty into Hudson Bay. Our 652,000 square kilometres of land mass is covered one-half by forest, one-third by farmland and one-eighth by fresh water. Our neighbours are the Canadian provinces of Manitoba and Alberta to our east and west respectively and the American states of Montana and North Dakota to the south.

Saskatchewan is culturally diverse with people of Aboriginal, British, European, Russian, Ukrainian, Polish and Scandinavian heritage.

## The Region

Saskatoon Health Region is one of the most integrated and complex health delivery agencies in Canada. We are the largest health region in Saskatchewan serving more than 300,000 residents in over 100 cities, towns, and rural municipalities. Saskatoon Health Region is the largest single employer in the province with over 11,000 staff and 750 physicians across the Region providing a complete range of health services to residents of central and northern Saskatchewan. The city's three acute care hospitals – St. Paul's, City, and Royal University – comprise the tertiary teaching centre for the province. In addition, one district hospital and six community hospitals serve the rural population outside the City of Saskatoon.

### General Practitioner

All candidates with British training in General Practice, full registration with GMC, and Certification with JCPTGP and PUETB will be considered.

### General Practitioner Anesthetist

All candidates with British training in General Practice, full registration with GMC, certification with JCPTGP and PMETB, certification/diploma in Anesthesia, and who have continued practicing as a GP, will be considered.
