

Eligibility Requirements

1. All nominees and nominators must be employees of Saskatoon Health Region.
2. Nominees may include managers and mentors (employees) who have participated in and/or supported mentorship within Saskatoon Health Region through the *Everyone Needs a Mentor!* initiative.
3. Nominees should have a sustained record of mentoring or supporting mentorship.
4. Nominators must be a mentee of the nominee or a colleague who has personal knowledge of the nominee's mentoring efforts.

Award Criteria

This award is based on the training experiences and success of the nominee's mentees/employees, not the mentor's/manager's personal career achievements. For the purpose of this award, mentoring is defined as:

A process whereby a more experienced person (the mentor) provides guidance, support, knowledge and opportunities to a less experienced individual (the mentee).

Mentorship values and respects the knowledge and learning needs of the participants; is based on voluntary and compassionate relationships; encourages the pursuit of excellence; decreases training and turn-over costs; and relies on and celebrates the partnership and collaboration of many.
