- Head, Clinical Biochemistry, St. Boniface General Hospital
- Assistant Professor, and Associate Professor, Department of Medicine, Section of Endocrinology, Faculty of Medicine, Medical College, University of Manitoba

Dr. Krahn is well known for his teaching expertise and has taught many courses to undergraduate, postgraduate and graduate students. In addition, he lectures both nationally and internationally. Research also plays a role in the work of this leader and he has been a co-investigator and collaborator on a several research projects.
