She completed her residency in Family Medicine at the General Hospital and Plains Health Centre in Regina in 1977. Throughout her medical career, firstly as a family physician in Prince Albert and later as a physiatrist in Saskatoon, Dr. Rudachyk has been a clinical faculty member of the College of Medicine. She served as Clinical Department Head for Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation for the Saskatoon Health Region from 1993 to 2000. From 2001 to 2006 she has been on the academic faculty as an Assistant Professor. She has served as Department Head of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation for both the University of Saskatchewan and the Saskatoon Health Region from 2001 to 2006.

In addition to her active clinical practice as a physiatrist and her administrative responsibilities, she is very actively involved in multiple teaching roles (undergraduate, postgraduate, continuing professional learning) and clinical research within the College of Medicine.
