Immunization Update For the Week of November 24th – 29th

pH1N1 Immunization will be available to the general public starting Wednesday November 25th in Saskatoon and rural communities. These clinics will provide first dose pH1N1. Second dose pH1N1 will be available starting December 7th for children age 6 months to less than 3 years and for children 3 years to less than 10 years with high risk medical conditions. Seasonal influenza vaccine will also be available at public clinics for the traditional high risk groups (except at U of S location). School immunization up to Grade 12 continues until December 5th. Physician offices who normally provide seasonal immunization will be receiving information from Public Health regarding the availability of pH1N1 vaccine.
