### Continuation of pH1N1 Immunization of At-Risk Groups

#### **Only For the following Identified At-Risk groups:**

- children over 6 months to less than 5 years of age
- pregnant women
- women who are up to 4 weeks postpartum
- medically at-risk persons **under age 35** years of age

At-risk medical conditions for persons **under age 35** include:

- heart disease
- asthma and chronic lung disease
- kidney disease
- difficulty handling respiratory secretions
- diabetes and other metabolic diseases
- weakened immune systems (people taking cancer drugs or people with HIV/AIDS)
- neurological disorders
- blood disorders
- conditions treated for long periods with ASA
- severe obesity.
