## We're here to help.

This group promotes language development through fun activities.

We welcome your child if they are four or five years old with language skills in the range of three- to four-year-olds.

This group aims to:

- Develop language skills
- Improve oral-motor skills
- Increase functional play skills
- Promote school readiness skills
- Enhance social skills



## What can I expect?

We ask that a parent or caregiver remain in the building during each session. In fact, you're encouraged to watch sessions via the observation room.

Therapists are happy to answer questions and share observations after each session. They can also provide additional ideas about how you can continue to practice language skills with your child at home.

Prior to the group's first meeting, one of our speech-language pathologists will book an orientation with you.

At this orientation, you'll:

- Tour our building and group room
- Learn what is expected of you
- Identify your goals and priorities
- Complete a baseline assessment of your child's speech and language abilities
- Complete a photo consent form
- Have a chance to ask questions

## How does the group

Each session includes:

- Opening circle
- Group activity
- Snack
- Functional play
- Closing circle

The speech-language pathologist will complete a daily progress note for your child. Once the group is finished, the therapist will meet with you personally to discuss your child's progress and offer completed treatment reports.

We create groups of no more than 10 children so your child can benefit from lots of hands-on attention.

Each session lasts about two and a half hours. Group runs three days per for four weeks.

A snack will be provided each day.
