

Family Physician COVID-19 Assessment Centre Saskatoon

The Saskatoon COVID-19 Assessment Centre (part of the overall Test and Assessment Centre), serves patients who are in need of hands-on, non-emergent medical care but are unable to see their own Primary Care Provider due to COVID-related reasons. We meet the needs of patients by providing in-person assessments, ordering appropriate outpatient investigations or prescriptions, and communicating care plans back to the patient's Family Physician. Referrals come from family physicians as well as Healthline 811.

We work with Nursing staff to assess patients of all ages and backgrounds. We also offer monoclonal antibody treatment (Sotrovimab) to eligible patients on site. In addition to booked appointments, we assess patients who are redirected by their nurse from the drive-through and test site if concerns are identified.

Competitive remuneration is by hourly stipend and will not affect your ability to bill MSB for non-pandemic-related work.

In-person upskilling with regards to Personal Protective Equipment will be provided.

Location: Saskatoon, Saskatchewan

Benefits: This is an independent contractor position therefore benefits are the responsibility of the successful candidate.

Qualifications: Eligibility for Canadian certification in Family Medicine, licensure in the province of Saskatchewan, and membership on the SHA Practitioners Staff.

Proof of COVID-19 vaccination will be required to become a member of Practitioner Staff and provide care in Saskatchewan Health Authority facilities.
