Position profile: Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) – Saskatoon and University of Saskatchewan (U of S), Department of Pediatrics, Division of Pediatric Rheumatology, is seeking a Full-Time Pediatric Rheumatologist to join our division. This is an exciting opportunity for a hospital-based practice where you will be joining two other Pediatric Rheumatologists to provide inpatient and outpatient care to the children of Saskatchewan. The successful candidate will become medical faculty in the Department of Pediatrics providing the highest standards of multidisciplinary care to children with a broad spectrum of rheumatic diseases from throughout the Province of Saskatchewan. The successful candidate will lead an innovative outreach clinical and research program to provide enhanced rural and remote care. In addition, the successful candidate will participate in developing and guiding strategies for improving the health and health care of Saskatchewan children with rheumatic diseases.



The successful applicant will participate in the educational activities of the Division with medical students and residents and will be encouraged to advance knowledge of childhood rheumatic diseases through scholarly research. On-call service is shared equally with a 1:3 call rota including coverage for evenings and weekends. The number of patient clinics provided will range from 3-4 half day clinics per week.
