

Enables women who are HIV positive in Saskatchewan to provide safe and appropriate nutrition to their newborns by covering the costs associated with formula. The delivery of a Provincial Infant Formula Program for infants born to women who are HIV Positive in Saskatchewan is a Prevention of Maternal to Child Transmission (PMTCT) strategy that complements current antenatal care with antiretroviral therapy. Infants born to women who are HIV positive will be eligible for the formula program from birth to 1 year of age unless the child is in the care of Child and Family Services where they are already eligible to access funding for formula.
