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### Calder Centre Covid-19 Memo:

Calder Centre provides a group based living environment. We have a number of updated procedures to ensure that Covid-19 risks are managed. The health and safety of our clients and staff is of primary importance. Below is a list of information that prospective clients should be aware of. This list is updated and amended as necessary.

- Upon arrival to Calder Centre all clients will be immediately screened for Covid-19 risk factors.
- Point of Care (POC) testing is in place at Calder Centre. This means that each client will get tested at admission as well as 3-4 days later. The purpose of Covid-19 surveillance is to prevent an outbreak from occurring.
- We encourage all clients to receive a Covid-19 vaccination prior to their admission. Please visit [www.saskatchewan.ca](http://www.saskatchewan.ca) for vaccine eligibility information.
- **Mask use for clients and staff is required at Calder Centre.** We will provide a supply of disposable masks. Clients and staff are to wear their mask at all times except while eating in the cafeteria and while in their own room. No cloth masks are accepted at this time.
- Any client who develops Covid-19 symptoms while at Calder Centre will be required to complete a point of care (POC) or rapid antigen (RAT) test. **If the result is positive, arrangements will be made for the client to isolate safely.**
- As per public health orders, all clients and staff are to practice safe physical distancing.
- Calder Centre will be working towards full bed occupancy- as a result, **clients are likely to have a roommate throughout their stay.**
- Ongoing hand hygiene is expected for all clients and staff. Hand sanitizer/soap dispensers are available throughout the building. **DO NOT bring personal hand sanitizers.**
- Restrictions for community access are in place for ALL clients. This means that there will be limited options for clients to leave Calder Centre for the duration of their treatment stay. **We advise clients to complete any medical/dental/housing/legal appointments prior to treatment.**
- Clients will be encouraged to provide support for daily cleaning and surface sanitization of shared spaces.
- Please arrive with all required personal items at admission (hygiene products, clothing, medication, cigarettes, etc.).
- **In person visitation restrictions are in place for clients.** Further information about visitation procedures will be provided to clients upon admission.
- Failure to follow expectations may result in a client being asked to leave treatment.
