



Royal University Hospital & Children's Hospital of Saskatchewan Site Update

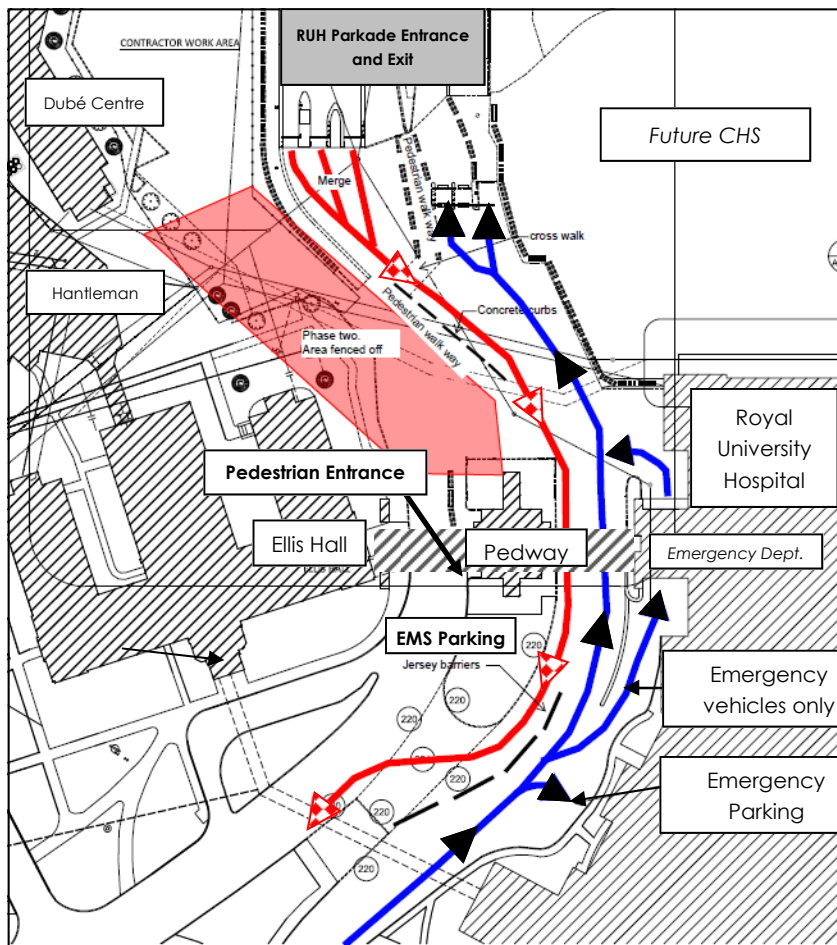

Construction for the new maternal and children's hospital main building continues with crews focusing on connecting water and sewer lines to Royal University Hospital systems.

New roadway changes will take effect week of October 19. This work is supporting rerouting of existing water and sewer lines that will interfere with pilings for the new hospital. Crews are digging up part of the road leading into and coming out of the Royal University Hospital parkade.

This construction will NOT affect where you enter the parkade. **It will affect how traffic arrives at and leaves the site.** Please also note...

- Incoming and outgoing traffic lanes continue to be reduced to single lanes
- Emergency vehicles will still have access to the ambulance bay.



Mid October to Early November

Incoming Parkade Traffic
(reduced to single lane into parkade)

Outgoing Parkade Traffic
(new path exit, single traffic lane)

Construction Zone - this area will be blocked off

All roadway changes will be clearly signed. Drive slowly and follow signs.

Please give yourself extra time when driving to and parking at Royal University Hospital.
