



Royal University Hospital & Children's Hospital of Saskatchewan Site Update

Significant Roadway Changes Expected Through September and October 2015

Construction for the new maternal and children's hospital main building has started. Crews will first focus on connecting water and sewer lines to Royal University Hospital systems. **This will affect traffic coming to and leaving from the site.** Entrances into and exits from the parkade will not change.

What is happening and where? In order to reroute existing water and sewer lines that interfere with pilings for the new hospital, crews will dig up part of the road leading into and coming out of the Royal University Hospital parkade.

When? It will happen in two phases starting the week of September 21. Each phase will result in an additional construction zone, resulting in the closure of some of the lanes leading to and coming out of the parkade. This means that...

- the path of incoming and outgoing traffic will change with each phase.
- incoming and outgoing traffic lanes will each be reduced into a single lane.
- emergency vehicles will still have access to the ambulance bay.

How does this affect me as a RUH staff or physician? If you park in the parkade, you will need to give yourself extra time to enter the parkade in order to arrive to work on time. This will be very important during peak shift change hours. Parking spots are not affected.

How does this affect my patients and their families? Inform your patients and their families to give themselves extra time to enter the parkade as well so this will not affect your clinic or procedure times. Parking spots are not affected.

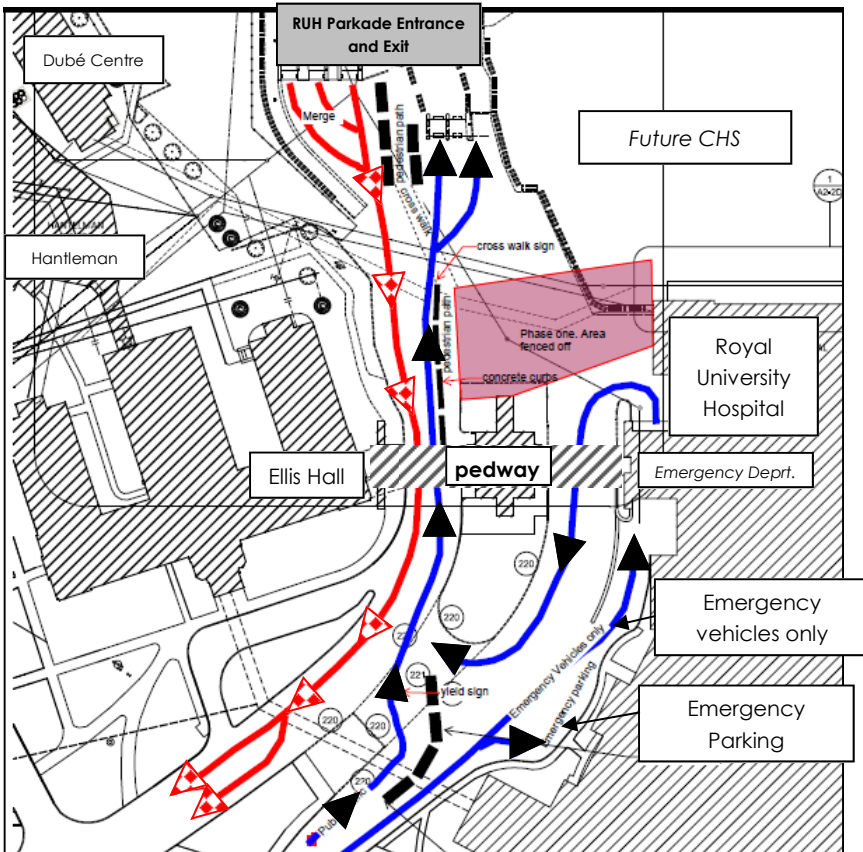
Will this affect pedestrian walkways outside the parkade next to the traffic lanes? Yes. We will be moving the pedestrian walkway currently next to the parkade traffic lanes as needed in order to maintain pedestrian safety. Please watch for and follow signage.

Will this happen again? Yes. The lanes will return back to 'normal' after the initial infrastructure connections are completed later in October. But, a few months later, these lanes will again be affected as other construction continues. This will also affect the pedestrian walkway next to the traffic lanes. More information will be shared later this fall.

What do I need to do? When coming to and leaving from the RUH site, please drive slowly and follow all signs to keep traffic moving smoothly and safely.

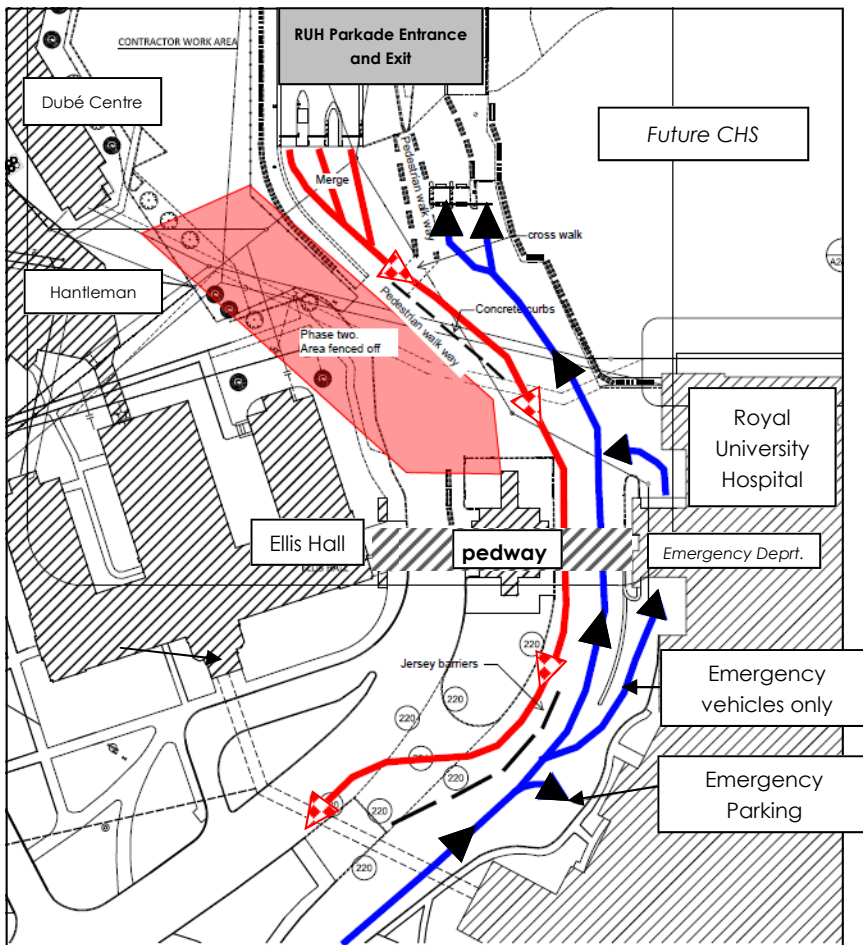
Phase 1 - Sept. 21- mid Oct.

(new path exit traffic lane, single lane)
